Beautification award recognizes improvements at Great Western Commerce Center

COLUMBUS, Ohio—**August 17, 2015**—The Friends of the Hilltop on Sunday presented <u>RD Management</u> with a with a Commercial Community Impact Award to recognize the investment that RD Management has made to restore and modernize <u>Great Western Commerce Center</u>.

The award was presented at Friends of the Hilltop's 19th annual Residential and Commercial Beautification Awards. The ceremony took place Sunday at the Hilltop Senior Village.

"We recognize that Columbus is a vibrant city with solid economic strength, and we see in the west side of Columbus an area for future growth."

For 19 years, The Friends of the Hilltop has presented beautification awards to neighborhood homeowners and businesses who have gone above and beyond to make improvements to their properties.

"We want RD Management to know that we want to partner with them in the Hilltop community," Huffman said. "Great Western has a big history in the neighborhood, and we are truly pleased at the turnaround."
